## *Admission Procedure*

### *M.B.A. Programme*

**Qualifying degree** : Graduation in any discipline from a recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate.

**Entrance Test** : A valid score in CMAT/CAT/XAT/JMET/MAT/State Level Management Entrance Test. Alternatively, candidates may appear in the Institute's Management Entrance Test\*.

**Personal Interview** : Conducted if candidates meet the above two criteria.

### *Ph.D. Programme*

Master's degree in Management or its equivalent with a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 5.5 on a 10-point scale or equivalent as determined by the Institute. Admission is through written test and interview.

**PRAGYAA-Journal of Management** (ISSN 0975 - 9603) : Pragyaa, the culmination of creative thinking, endlessly strives to inform and educate its readers in current business thinking, practices and skills.

## *Learning Resources*

The FMS library docks over 10010 books on functional and contemporary management topics along with world class literature. FMS subscribes to more than 75 national and international journals and periodicals, which are reviewed regularly for quality and information validity. CDs and audio-visual resources are also available for the consumption of students and teachers.



**Digital Library :** Digital library gives the access to all kind of learning information. It is a knowledge library equipped with high-end computers and databases.

**SPSS 17.0 :** It is a computer program used for statistical analysis. SPSS is among the most widely used programs for statistical analysis in social sciences. It includes various base software such as Descriptive statistics, Explore, Descriptive Ratio Statistics, Bi-variate statistics, Mean, t-test, ANOVA, Correlation and Non-parametric tests.

**EBSCO-Business Source Complete :** It offers access to 1824 indexed and abstracted periodicals, 1089 full-text periodicals, 927 peer-reviewed indexed and abstracted journals, 473 peer-reviewed full-text journals and 10,000 company profiles.

**PROWESS :** It is a database, which enables querying and research through a structured data selection prowess. It contains normalize data on about 10,000 Indian companies applicable for financial analysis, industry analysis, feasibility studies and the like. It is updatable daily at the users end.
