

PLACEMENTS DETAILS

The growth of the MITS University can be seen from its student's placement records. The MITS is known as a credible institution of repute and also recognized by the top multinational companies who are recruiting its students regularly through campus placements and pursuing the University for the Place of first recruiter.

From 2009 batch of Engineering Students, 95% were effectively placed. This batch bagged as many as 532 offer letters against 289 students. Major recruiters were TCS (129 Nos.), ACCENTURE (94 Nos.), INFOSYS (115 Nos.), SATYAM (84 Nos.), IBM (43 Nos.), etc.

Major recruiters for 2010 batch were INFOSYS (149 Nos.), IBM (84 Nos.), ACCENTURE (30 Nos.), CGI (14 Nos.), Nokia Siemens (06 Nos.), Cap Gemini (05 Nos.), TCS (04 Nos.), Education & Research (17 Nos.) etc.

The placement for 2011 batch: FET students: INFOSYS (111), ACCENTURE (188) and IBM (128) Secure Meters (03), Birla Soft (03), HCL Comnet (02), Huawei Technologies (07). Also MBA students have been placed in Ritusha Consulting (An associate for Hewlett Packard Educations) (10), Bank of Baroda (03), Sharekhan (16), Tea exchange Bharat Limited (05), Tele performance (05). IBM Daksh and Vipro have selected 29 and 09 students respectively from FASC.

Ms. Paridhi Jain, a student of Faculty of Engineering & Technology, MITS was selected to visit Japan for 15 Days from 1st to 15th September, 2009, as a part of Japanese Language Programme for Outstanding Students Programme. She was one of the two Genus Students from India who were selected for this programme. She is also selected for MEXT Scholarship of Japan for pursuing M. S. in Electrons and Photonics, from 2011 to 2013 at Keio University, Yokohama, Japan. The Scholarship amount is worth Rs. 23 Lakhs plus Tuition Fees and Technical Assistance.
