VII. PROFILE OF DIRECTOR WITH QUALIFICATIONS, TOTAL EXPERIENCE, AGE AND duration of employment at the institute CONCERNED:

Prof. Pradip Kumar Das, Professor & Dean, Faculty of Engineering & Technology, MITS is a former professor of Jadavpur University, where he taught for 35 long years - first in the Department of Electronics & Tele-Communication Engineering and subsequently in the Department of Computer Science & Engineering. A Bachelor of Electronics Engineering degree with Honours in 1968 and a Master of Electronics Engineering with specialization in Computer Engineering in 1970, Prof. Das joined the Computer Group of the Tata Institute of Fundamental Research, visited and worked in many countries in Europe, Japan and USA and was awarded a Commonwealth fellowship and a fellowship of the Japan International Cooperation Agency. He did post-doctoral research in the Computer Science department of the Queen's University of Belfast in UK.

Prof. Das has guided nine Ph.D. theses and numerous Master's dissertations. He has published nearly 80 research papers, mostly in International journals and conferences. Prof. Das is a senior member of the Institute of Electrical & Electronics Engineers, USA and a Fellow of the Institution of Engineers, India and has been the founder director of the School of Mobile Computing & Communication in Jadavpur University.

He is also associated with many industries and is a member of the board of West Bengal Electronics Industry Development Corporation and a member of the Senate of the Indian Institute of Information Technology, Allahabad. He has also been a regular member of the National Bureau of Accreditation teams of the AICTE, Govt. of India and has also successfully guided various projects funded by the then Department of Electronics, Ministry of Communication & Information Technology, Indian Space Research Organization, Department of Science & Technology, Department of Scientific & Industrial Research, United Nation Development Program, Hewlett Packard Philanthropic Trust, etc.

Prof. Das is a member of the Steering Committee of the prestigious International Conference in Distributed Computing & Networking (ICDCN).
