MITS maintains close interaction with foreign universities / institutes of repute like Carleton University of Canada, GSI Helmholtz, Darmstadt, Germany and GE Foundation, USA. We have also signed Memoranda of Understanding with CSIR Laboratories like CEERI-Pilani and CMERI-Durgapur and all these MoU's have since been operationalized.

Some of the significant events with regard to Industry-Institute interaction are as follows:

- The Director, Real-time & Distributed System Laboratory of Carleton University visited our institute in November, 2010.
- He delivered a set of eight lectures on Distributed Computing under faculty orientation program.
- Two G.E. Foundation Scholarships of US\$ 4500 each, tenable for two years, have been awarded to two of our B.Tech. students – one from the Department of Computer Science & Engineering & another from the Department of Electronics & Communication Engineering.
- One student of B.Tech. (I.T.) III year is doing her summer internship for two months in GSI, Darmstadt, Germany with scholarship and travel assistance awarded by GSI.
- Four students of M.Tech. (VLSI) have been selected for summer internship in GSI, Darmstadt, Germany.
- Active interaction is underway to work towards research collaboration with John F. Welch Technology Centre of GE, USA in emerging areas of research such as Solar Energy and Nanotechnology.
